CEMETERY GUIDELINES

Beth David Memorial Gardens is dedicated to maintaining charm, warmth and integrity for the families we currently serve and for generations to come. As part of our mission to comfort the living we have instituted the following cemetery guidelines to uphold Beth David in a neat and presentable manner:

Beth David will not assume any liability for any ornamentation or personal property/effects placed on the cemetery grounds.

We recommend that families take this into consideration when leaving flowers or ornamentation on graves, crypts or niches.

Community Mausoleums

- **<u>Beth David will conduct pressure washing of mausoleums biannually-June & December</u>**

 For the safety of our visitors and staff the following is not permitted:
 - ❖ Must always keep walkways clear of ornamentation/visitation stones/personal effects
 - No planters/vases of any material are allowed on the walkways and will be removed without notice
 - All flowers must be in a cemetery approved vase attached to the granite crypt or niche front
 - No ornamentation is permitted to be left on the walkways or it will be removed without notice
 - No ornamentation is permitted be hung on the granite crypt or niche fronts or it will be removed without notice
 - -(i.e.:. flowers, cards, balloons, stuffed animals, pictures)

Community Gardens

The following items are NOT permitted and will be removed without notice:

- Artificial Flowers
- Glass vases/containers
- Flags, pinwheels, stake lights, stuff animals
- Artificial ornamentation/personal effects
- Planting of Plants/Trees/Flowers

FLORAL and PLANTING GUIDELINES

- Only previous contracts for trees/plantings will be honored, NO new plantings of trees will be allowed by Cemetery Management
- No Artificial Flowers Permitted
- No Glass Vases/Containers Permitted
- Flowers can only be placed in cemetery approved granite or temporary vases
 - See Cemetery Advisor for approved vase options
- Any unapproved plantings will be removed by the cemetery without notice
- All floral arrangements will be removed once wilted

GRANITE UPKEEP

Beth David will not be responsible for any damage or discoloration caused by visitation stones, ornamentation or floral arrangements left directly on granite by visitors

PLEASE NOTE THE FOLLOWING AND SHARE WITH FAMILIES & FRIENDS:

- Granite is a natural stone, that is cut directly from the earth, so imperfections or discolorations are possible.
- Granite is a porous material; therefore, it will absorb and retain anything that it encounters for an extended period, especially moisture. Granite will appear darker when wet and lighter when dry.
- ❖ Granite can easily scratch and stain-<u>DO NOT</u> leave flower arrangements, ornamentation and/or large, rough, dirt filled visitation stones on any granite, or it will possibly damage and stain the granite.

GRANITE GUIDELINES

- Cemetery Management, Property Owner and Next of Kin must approve memorial drawings before production is started.
- The memorial process takes 120 Days and Custom orders/colors can take up to 180 days.
- ❖ Memorials must be installed before an Unveiling is scheduled.
- Upright Monument memorials are only allowed in the following sections:
 - Mt. Scopus, Moses, Shalom Monument, Sinai Monument, Cohanim North and South, Family Estates
- Slant memorials are only allowed in the following sections:
 - Moriah I-IV
- Flat memorials are allowed in all community gardens throughout the cemetery
