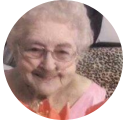

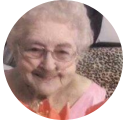

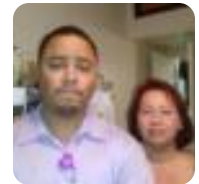
Fran posted:

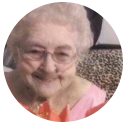

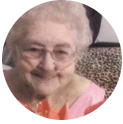
