Phyllis was a long time resident of Aventura, Florida, where she was well known for her creativity and outstanding community involvement.

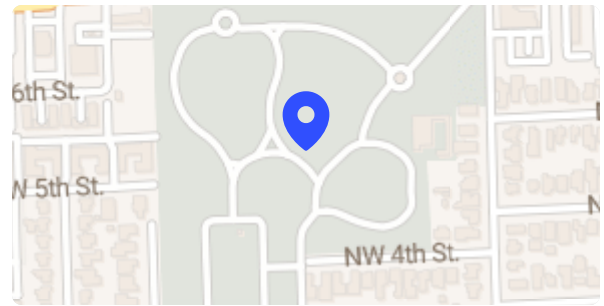
