He loved reuniting with high school buddies. Lefty served as a corporal in Korea (receiving numerous service medals) and was very proud to be a vet. When he returned, he attended the University of Miami and worked in the restaurant business. He owned the Corral Restaurant in Westchester, and worked in wholesale restaurant sales for many years. He loved to draw, write poetry, recite Shakespeare, and talk politics and sports. 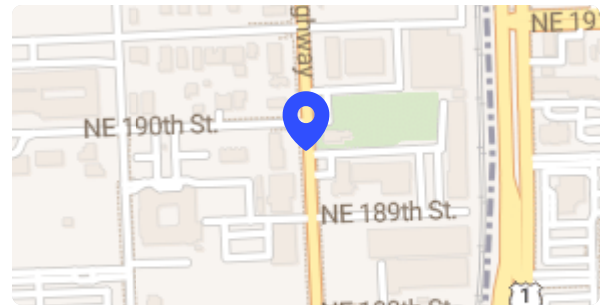

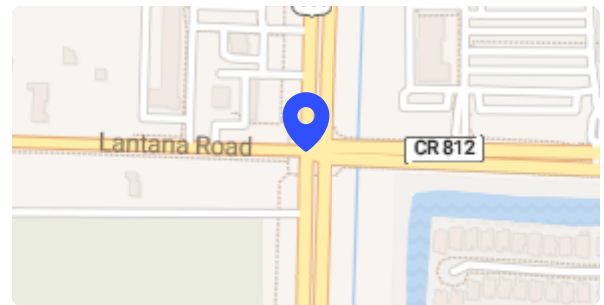
