Joined the Army in 1945-47. Moved to Miami with wife Roslyn in 1951. He was a founder of Temple Or Olom in Miami. In January 1954 received his CPA certificate. Milt became a partner in Bramson, Schechter, Beame and Davis, which grew to be a major local accounting firm. He was President of the Optimist Club.

He had two loves in his life. Roslyn who had passed away at 35 years. He married Fran in 1966 bringing two fantastic families together as one. They always stressed family is about loving and caring and had pearl rings made for the girls and initial rings for the boys. 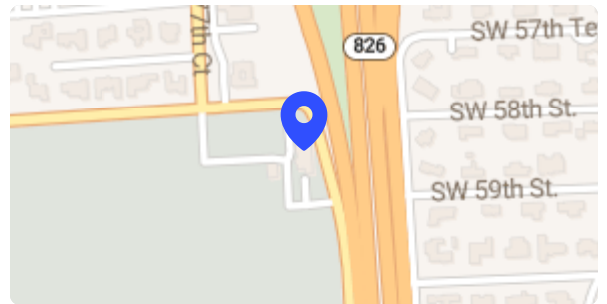

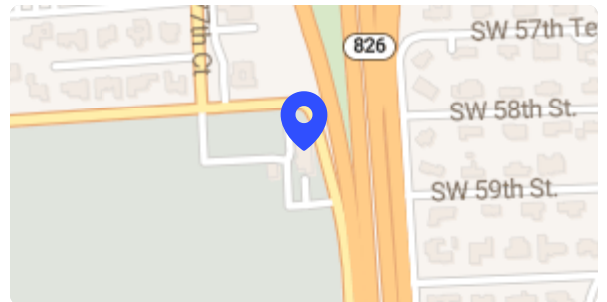
