Rand, Jay Milton, age 84, passed away peacefully surrounded by his family December 15, 2015. Jay was born on May 18, 1931 in Bronx, NY to Abraham Rand and Goldie Weiner Rand. After graduating Miami Beach High School in 1949, Jay served two years in the US Army in Korea. He graduated from the University of Miami.

He married the love of his life, Eileen Solomon Rose, August 28, 1959. He is survived by his wife of 56 years and their four children: Hilary Rose, Robin Rose (Karen), Andrew Rand (Sid) and Erin Buzzella (James); seven grandchildren: Ericka, Naomi, Micah, Jonathan, Sequoia, Jasmine and Trey; and four great-grandchildren: Alex, Kylianne, Aidan and William. 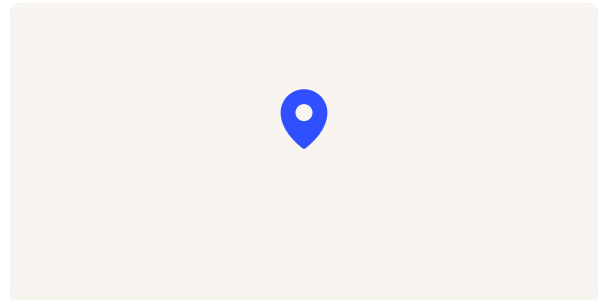
