Alexander F. Yahr, 46, passed away February 8, 2018 at his home in Hollywood.

A native of Miami Beach, Alex was born June 4, 1971 to Sonia and Dr. William Yahr. Alex is survived by his wife, Katie, and their four legged daughter, Bella. He was the brother of Elizabeth Yahr Southard and Harriette Yahr, uncle to Ashley and Ryan Southard, and cousin to Marc, Lisa and Erica Yahr.

Alex was a licensed general contractor, successful realtor, and designer whose distinguished style is evident in properties across South Florida. 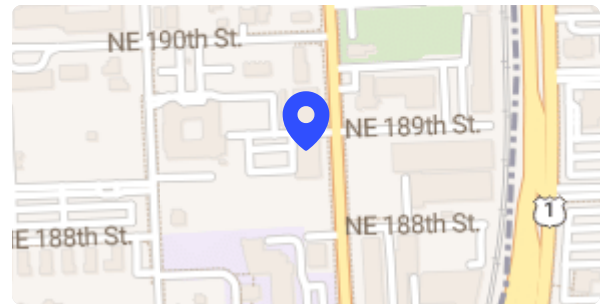

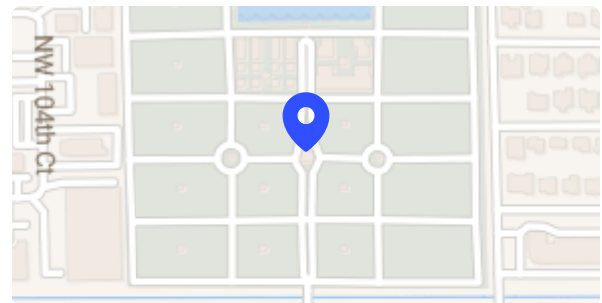
