Edward J. Lesen, 81, of Hallandale Beach, FL (formerly of Yonkers, NY) passed away on April 24th, 2019 after a brief illness. Ed retired from the New York City Board of Education where he worked as a guidance counselor. A longtime activist, contributor to his community and charitable organizations, Ed was Treasurer of the Broward County Chapter of the National Organization for Women and former President of Southern Westchester NOW. He was a founder of the Broward Women's Emergency Fund and My Sister's Place, a domestic violence shelter in Westchester, NY, and former President of the Board of Directors of the Hemispheres Condo Assoc. Ed was passionate about justice, women's rights, humor, music, and culture. Beloved and missed by many friends and family, Ed is survived by his life partner Clarice Pollock, daughter Amy, stepdaughter Linda, and stepsons Dennis, Patrick, and Kevin. 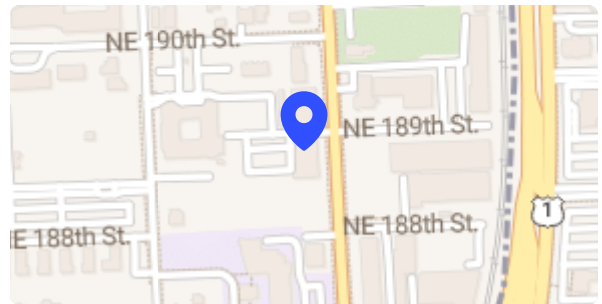

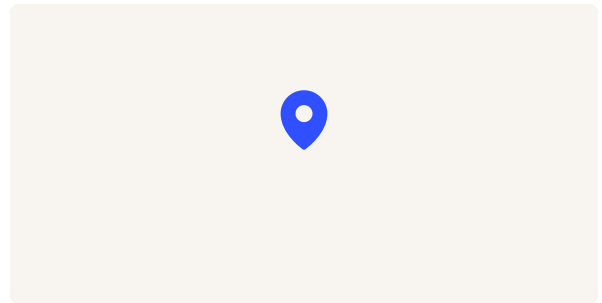
