Doris Olesky of Bay Harbor Islands passed away on Sunday, January 19th at the age of 100. Doris was born in the Bronx to Herman Jacobs and Mary Greenspan and was the youngest sister to Pauline, Mildred, and Lillian. She graduated Georgian Court College in Lakewood, NJ in 1940. Doris is predeceased by Henry “Hank” Olesky, her husband of nearly 50 years. Doris was a revered teacher at Biscayne Elementary and at Bay Harbor Elementary. She also partnered with her sister Lillian as owners of Melony’s Wardrobe, a children’s clothing store. 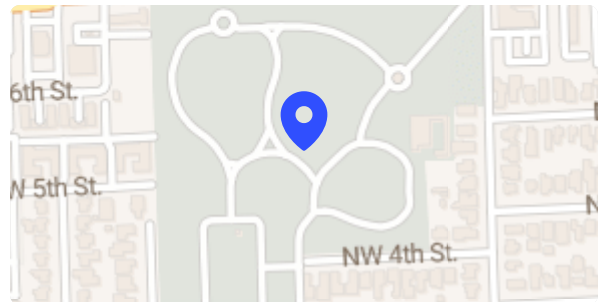
