**E**laine “Pixie” Lewis, age 95, of Houston Texas, passed away peacefully Tuesday, April 11, 2023, at her residence surrounded by her sons. Pixie was the only child of her parents, Morton and Mildred “Mimi” Pearlman. She met her beloved husband, Melvin Lewis, at the beachfront at Lake Michigan in Chicago. Both had attended college at Roosevelt University and were married in Chicago, Illinois. They honeymooned in Miami and quickly decided to make Miami their home. Pixie continued her education, earning a masters degree in education. She continued working as a teacher while maintaining a home, raising their sons, and caring for her aging mother and mother in-law.

She was an only child and doted on by her husband. Pixie was widowed at the age of 60, after which she became progressively more independent. She moved to Houston in 2007 to be closer to her son, Steven. 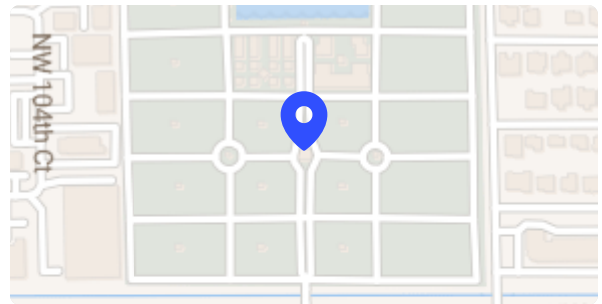

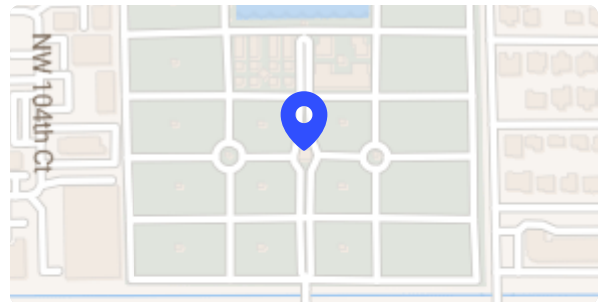
