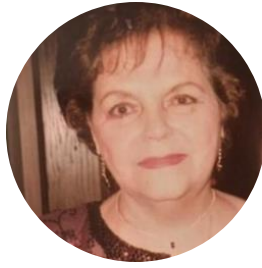

AUG 28, 1936 - SEP 15, 2023

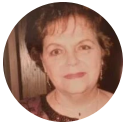
**M**ilagros Lane, affectionately known as Millie, passed away peacefully in the early morning of Friday, September 15, 2023. Millie was surrounded by her loved ones in the comfort of her home, where she had lived for the past 56 years. Born in Guanica, Puerto Rico to parents Antonio and Carmen Morciglio on August 28, 1936, Millie learned the importance of family, kindness, loyalty and hard work. She was an exceptional student, who graduated high school two years ahead of her class. Millie never forgot where she came from and treated all people with respect.

Puerto Rico shaped Millie's life immeasurably, and she treasured her time on the island. Millie would radiate with pride when she visited. Millie was an extremely helpful and hands-on grandmother, always lending a caring hand and nurturing spirit to her grandchildren.

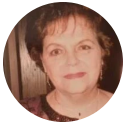

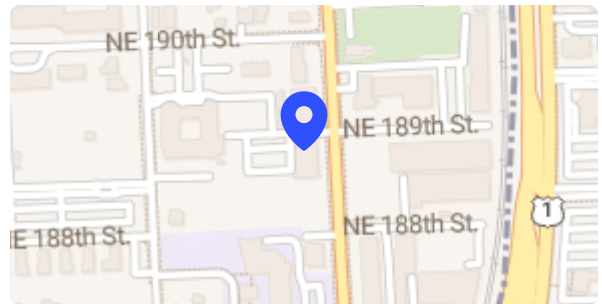

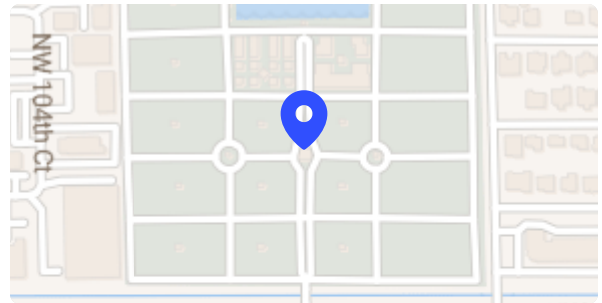
