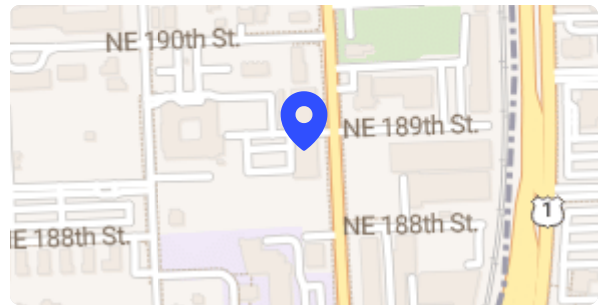

Steve and I were best friends in high school, New City NY. We had many adventures and misadventures. I was saddened tonight to read of his passing.



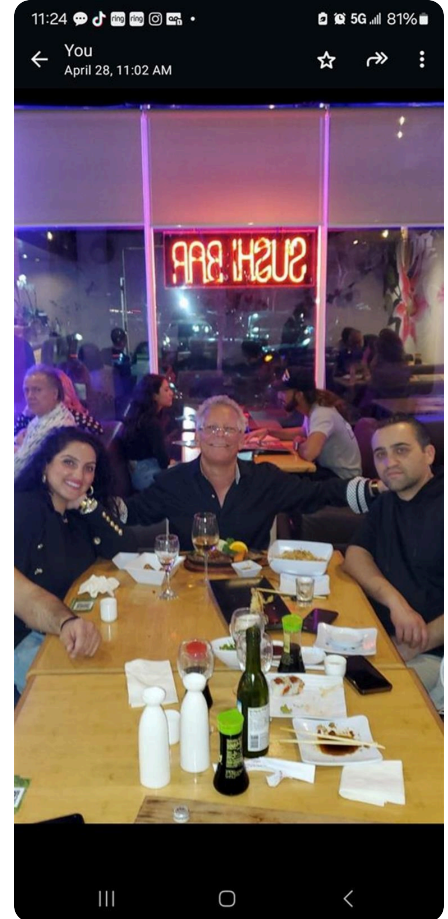
