North Miami Beach – December 26, 1940 – April 30, 2024

Born in Detroit Michigan, Neal was Predeceased by his Parents, Jay Burton Keys and Shirley Ann Keys and his Sister Nancy K. Bloom. Neal's Wife, Larysa Keys, and Sons, Anton Drobentsov and Pavel (Maevé) Drobentsov and his beloved Grandchildren Luka and Isabella were all by his side until the end. He is also survived by his Sister, Carol F. (Neal Starkey), Keys, Nephew Simon H. (Ellie) Bloom, III and Niece Sharon (Justin Shacklette) Bloom and Grandnieces Clare Jaye and Bryce Anne Shacklett and Elizabeth, Louise and Katherine Bloom.

Neal grew up in North Miami and in 1973 he built his home in Eastern Shores, North Miami Beach, where he was an active director of the homeowners' association for decades. 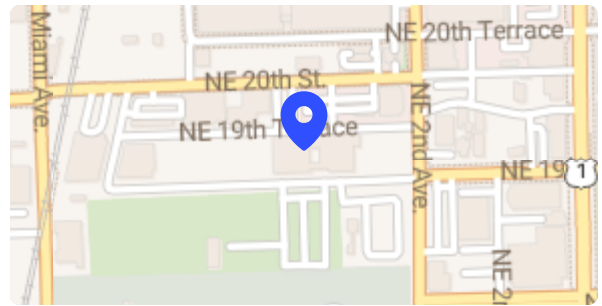

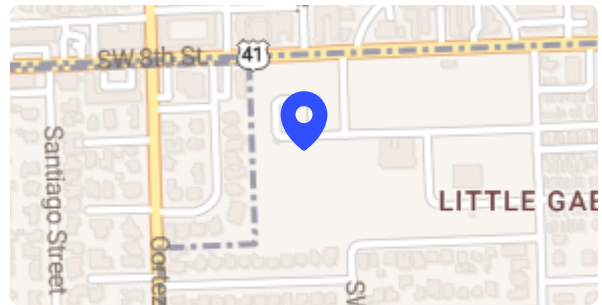
