# Stuart Richard Garber

**S**tuart R. Garber passed away peacefully on November 10, 2025 at the age of 81, in Alexandria, Virginia. He was a loving Husband, Dad, Partner, Grandpa, and Uncle who will be dearly missed.

Stu was born on October 22, 1944 in New York City to Harry and Lillian Garber. He attended high school in Manhattan and then Pace College, earning his degree in Business Administration in 1966. He then attended Long Island University earning his Masters in Business Administration in 1971.

Growing up working with his electrician father, he developed an interest in construction and building. These experiences and his education led to a position with Miami based General Development Corporation where he worked for many years. Later in his career he began developing and building his own projects in South Florida before retiring.

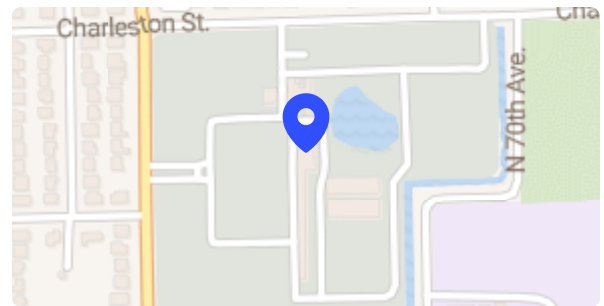

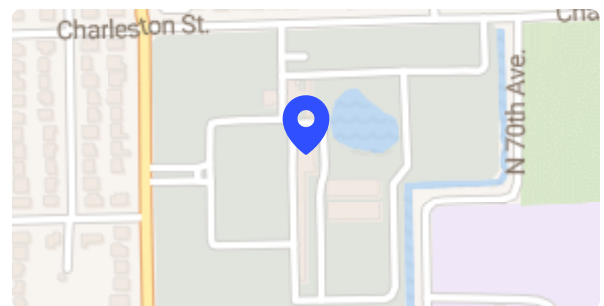

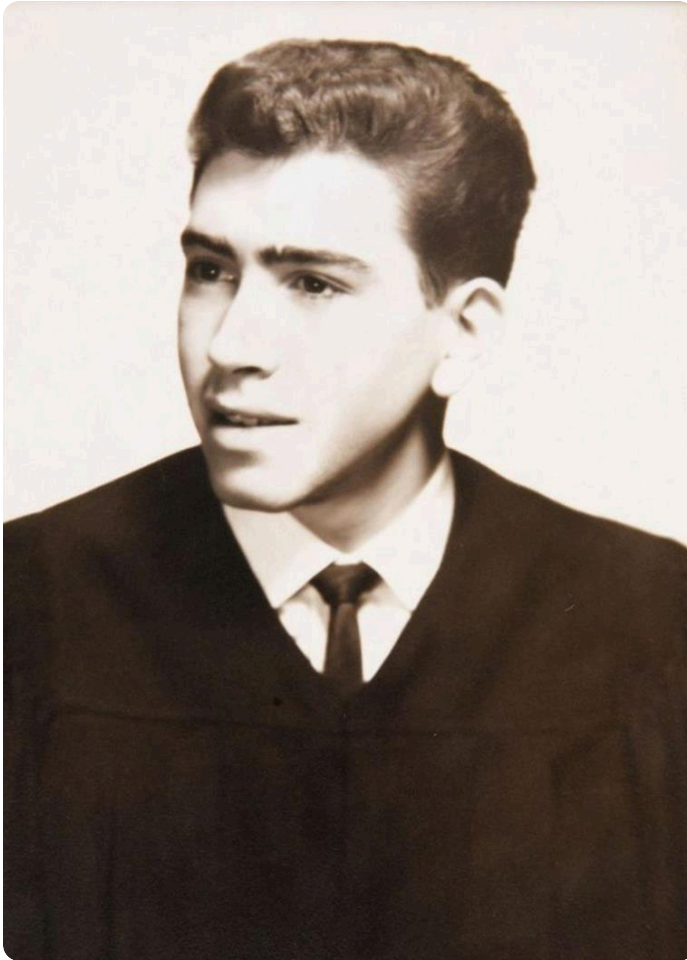
