She also got MTA (Metro Transit Authority) to provide a bus for the local junior high school for children who had no way to get home from school.

She volunteered countless hours for the National Kidney Foundation, Hospice, Dade County Schools, Sunland Training Center and the Broward County Library System. She and Hank traveled the world in the last two decades or so and loved meeting all sorts of people around the world.
