After an honorable discharge. He entered podiatry school where he graduated from Temple School of Podiatry. His surgical residency was at Temple as well. He was a original founding member of the academy of ambulatory foot and ankle surgery, a speciality organization in minimal invasive foot surgery.

Samuel practiced over 50 years in Salem, New Jersey. In addition he was a licensed board of Health Officier. He also was Salem City register of Vital Statistics. Samuel was the first podiatrist to become president of Health System Agency. This agency was developed by President Ford to allow local healthcare planning.

Samuel is survived by his wife Barbara. They were married for over 60 years. Son of the late Ceil and Jacob Zuckerman.
